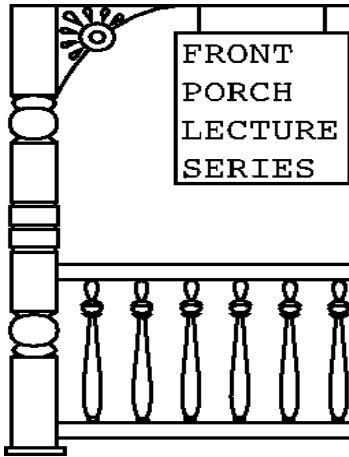

About the Presenter:

Sir Richard Bowlby is the son of Dr. John Bowlby, the originator of the concept of attachment as a biological, survival-related process. Dr. Bowlby wrote extensively about the importance of early relationships in facilitating or hindering normal development across the life-span. In 1995, understanding the importance of his father's lifetime of work, Richard Bowlby made the decision to take early retirement from his career as a Medical Photographer to use his considerable talents to bring to infant mental health specialists, day-care providers, nursery and preschool teachers--all over the world--the importance of developing secure attachment relationships in early life. Sir Richard's candid and down-to-earth manner of presenting the ideas, and rich use of videotapes showing attachment behaviors is both informative and engaging.

Location:

Naropa University, Nalanda Campus: 6287 Arapahoe Avenue, Boulder.

Parking: Nalanda has two parking lots; one on the south side of the building at the corner of 63rd and Arapahoe and one on the northwest side of the building. Please do not park in other businesses' parking lots, undesignated parking spaces or in any grass areas. To access the northwest parking lot: 1) from Arapahoe Ave. turn north on to 63rd St. and take your third left just before the railway tracks. 2) If you are coming from Valmont, turn south onto 63rd Ave. and take your first right just over the railway tracks. Additional street parking is available on 62nd St.

Buses: The JUMP bus stops in front of the Nalanda Campus, and runs seven days a week. Please check for exact schedule.
